**WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES**  
**CAREFULLY READ THE INFORMATION BELOW**

1. All entries and competition in the Tournament must be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) and of this Association.
2. This Tournament is open to all women members of the Allentown Area USBC Association (AAUSBC). All members must be current and in good standing.
3. No entries will be accepted after the closing date of April 5, 2010. No change will be made in scheduled times, except in the case of emergency and approved by the Tournament Manager.
4. Entrants will use their highest final USBC certified league average from last season, including summer leagues. If entrant did not bowl last season, this season's average as of March 1<sup>st</sup> will be used (based on a minimum of 21 games up to March 1<sup>st</sup>). All other bowlers must bowl scratch. USBC Rule 319A-2 (10 pins increase over last year's average) is waived for this tournament. USBC Rule 319-D (bowlers must report qualifying for prizes of \$300.00 or more (is waived for this tournament).
5. Handicap shall be 90% of 200 scratch for all divisions. All averages shall receive full handicap. Actual scores shall decide All Event winners in each class.
6. A team shall consist of five (5) bowlers. Entrants shall bowl in order listed on the entry form. Bowlers may compete twice in the Team Event. Scores from the first Team Event will count towards All Event totals. A bowler may compete only once in Minor Events.
7. All Events shall consist of three divisions:
  - Class 1 – 175 & over
  - Class 2 – 140 to 174
  - Class 3 – 139 & under
8. Tournament awards will be given to Champions in every event. Special awards from the AAUSBC shall include:
  - Lucille Hersh Award for the highest game in Class 3.
9. Prize fees shall be paid 100% in cash prizes. Teams and individuals shall be eligible for only one prize in each event, that being the higher prize. Only those entrants who pay the \$4.00 entry fee qualify for participation in the All-Events Championship.
10. Captains and Doubles partners shall report 30 minutes before scheduled event. When making substitutions, report at least one hour before scheduled event.
11. All three games of each event shall be bowled on one pair of lanes. Doubles and Singles entrants shall flip-flop for singles, after doubles have been completed. Three sets shall bowl on a pair of lanes for both the Singles and Doubles Events.
12. Teams and or individuals arriving late shall begin play and the scores shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Entrant will receive a zero for frames missed
13. If an entrant is late for the doubles event, the entrant present shall bowl her single event first. If her partner has not arrived by the time the singles event is completed and a substitute is not found, the entrant person shall be permitted to bowl in the doubles event to qualify for All Events.
14. A tournament entrant will not be allowed to re-bowl a game or series unless authorized by the Tournament Manager when the scores are irretrievably lost from an automatic score device.
15. In the event a team is unopposed on a pair of lanes, each frame shall be completed on one lane before the next frame is started on the adjoining lane.
16. Substitutes in all three events may enter all events if replacing a bowler in the same class. A substitute shall not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee paid nor shall the substitute be expected to give entrant any prize or award she may win.
17. Practice balls shall be allowed on each of the starting lanes before the start of the five-person Team Event. Practice balls shall be permitted on each of the starting lanes before the start of the Singles Event. **THERE WILL BE NO PRACTICING ON OPEN LANES THE DAY YOU ARE SCHEDULED TO BOWL.**
18. Entry fee can be returned at the discretion of the Tournament Manager.
19. Unmarried Grade and High School students who have not reached the age of eighteen (18) must have written consent of their parents or legal guardian in order to participate in any USBC certified league or tournament where cash or merchandise is offered, unless the student is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, in which case the parental consent form may be filed up to the time the student starts to bowl. (See USBC Playing Rules, Rule 13)
