AAUSBC WOMEN'S CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES
CAREFULLY READ THE INFORMATION BELOW

1. This Tournament is open to all adult women members of the Allentown Area USBC Association (AAUSBC).
2. All entries and competition in the Tournament must be in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) and of this Association.
3. Entrants will use their highest final USBC certified league average from the previous season, including summer leagues. If the entrant did not bowl last season, this season's average as of March 1st will be used (based on a minimum of 21 games up to March 1st). All other bowlers must bowl scratch. USBC Rule 319a-2 (10 pin increase over last year's average) is waived for this tournament. USBC Rule 319d (bowlers must report qualifying for prizes of \$600.00 or more) is waived for this tournament.
4. Handicap shall be 90% of 200 scratch for all divisions. All averages shall receive full handicap. Actual scores shall decide All Event winners in each class.
5. A bowler may compete four (4) times in the Team Event of this tournament. No more than three (3) players on the same team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. A bowler may enter twice in the Minor Events of this tournament. No player may cash more than once in doubles with the same partner. A bowler may cash only once in singles. In all cases, a bowler's first score (including substitutions) in each event shall count towards All-Events.

Bowlers competing in Minor Events must enter both singles and doubles.
6. All Events shall consist of three divisions:
 Class 1 – 175 and over
 Class 2 – 140 to 174
 Class 3 – 139 and under
7. Prize fees shall be paid 100% in cash prizes. Teams and individuals shall be eligible for only one prize in each event, that being the higher prize. Only those entrants who pay the \$4.00 entry fee qualify for participation in the All-Events Championship.
8. Claims for errors in the tournament prize list must be made within 30 days of the AAUSBC Spring meeting, when tournament prizes are awarded.
9. Captains and Doubles partners shall report 30 minutes before scheduled event. When making substitutions, report at least one hour before scheduled event.
10. Teams and or individuals arriving late shall begin play and the scores shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Entrant will receive a zero for frames missed
11. A tournament entrant will not be allowed to re-bowl a game or series unless authorized by the Tournament Manager when the scores are irretrievably lost from an automatic score device.
12. In the event a team is unopposed on a pair of lanes, each frame shall be completed on one lane before the next frame is started on the adjoining lane.
13. Substitutes in all three events may enter All-Events if replacing a bowler in the All-Events. A substitute shall not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee paid nor shall the substitute be expected to give entrant any prize or award she may win.
14. Practice balls shall be allowed on each of the starting lanes before the start of the four-person Team Event. Practice balls shall be permitted on each of the starting lanes before the start of the Doubles Event. **THERE WILL BE NO PRACTICING ON OPEN LANES THE DAY YOU ARE SCHEDULED TO BOWL.**
15. Entry fees can be returned at the discretion of the Tournament Manager.
16. Unmarried Grade and High School students who have not reached the age of eighteen (18) must have the written consent of their parents or legal guardian in order to participate in any USBC certified league or tournament where cash or merchandise is offered, unless the student is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, in which case the parental consent form may be filed up to the time the student starts to bowl. (See USBC Rule 13)
17. Falsifying Averages-Penalty: Each bowler shall be responsible for reporting her average correctly on the entry filed. Highest league affiliation, regardless of association of individuals, shall be responsible to and with the team captain. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than actual average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average
18. The Tournament Committee reserves all rights to act on any situation not covered by the above Rules and Regulations.
