LEHIGH VALLEY WOMEN'S "600" CLUB 2009 FUN TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The LEHIGH VALLEY WOMEN'S "600" BOWLING CLUB shall conduct a SCOTCH DOUBLES FUN TOURNAMENT for its members. At least one participant must be a member of the LEHIGH VALLEY WOMEN'S "600" BOWLING CLUB and must be USBC certified for the current year.
2. The Tournament shall be held in an association according to the rotation plan set up by the club; the current rotation is: Slate Belt, Easton, Bethlehem, Monroe County, Palmerton and Allentown. If any association declines, the rotation shall continue with the next association.
3. Entries shall OPEN four weeks prior to the tournament date and CLOSE ½ hour prior to squad time unless squad is full.
4. The Secretary-Treasures will be the tournament manager. The President will appoint one member from the tournament city to secure lanes and scorekeepers in the Association where the tournament is held.
5. All Entrants must sign the official score sheets. Any error must be reported within 24 hours. Where telescopes and/or automatic scorers are available, they will be official.
6. The Prize List will be based on at least one prize in every ten entries. Checks in payment of money prizes won will be mailed to the winners within thirty (30) days after the close of the Tournament.
7. In case of a tie for first place, duplicate awards will be presented. However, the first and second place prize money will be added together and divided equally.
8. The officers and directors of the LEHIGH VALLEY WOMEN'S "600" BOWLING CLUB shall decide any questions not covered in the tournament rules and their decisions shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
9. Scotch Doubles format will be used: Partner #1 throws the first ball. Partner #2 shoots the spare. If Partner #1 gets a strike, then Partner #2 throws the first ball of the next frame, and Partner #1 will shoot the spare, and so on.
10. Handicap will be 90% of the Team Average limit of 420, which will then be divided in half for each game since each bowler is only bowling half a game.
11. Each entrant shall bowl five (5) games on one pair of lanes.
12. The highest USBC certified average from the previous winter league will be used. If no previous winter average, the highest USBC certified average from the previous summer league (minimum of 21 games) will be used. If no previous summer average, the current highest USBC certified league average will be used (minimum of 12 games). If no current average is available, the bowler will bowl Scratch average of 210. Failure to use the correct average will result in disqualification. USBC Rule 319a (2) (the 10 pin increase in average) does not apply. USBC Rule 319d requiring an entrant to report her previous tournament prize winnings as a condition for entry does not apply. USBC Rule 319c on re-rating does not apply.
13. Tournament entry forms will be sent to "all" currently sanctioned members of the Lehigh Valley Women's "600" Bowling Club in good standing.
14. Cost of bowling in tournament: Bowling and Expense Fee: Option of the Tournament Manager based on current lane prices, Prize Fee: \$14.00.
15. Entrant may bowl ONCE. No re-entry.
16. Unmarried grade and high school students 18 and under must file parental consent form before bowling.
17. Lehigh Valley Women's "600" Bowling Club dues may be mailed with entry.
18. All winners are subject to verification by the Tournament Manager.
19. USBC Rule 319e is waived.
20. This tournament is USBC certified.
